THIS AGREEMENT, made this 15th day of May, A. D. 1925, between Oscar Drumheller and Elizabeth Drumheller, husband and wife, of the County of Walla Walla, State of Washington, parties of the first part, and I. M. Schannep, R. E. Bean and J. O. Hales of the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon as the County Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, sitting for the transaction of County Business, as parties of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the covenants on the part of the said parties of the second part hereinafter contained hereby covenants with said parties of the second part that said parties of the first part does by these presents hereby fully discharge, satisfy and release said parties of the second part from the performance by them of the terms of that certain judgment of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County in that certain law action number 3000 wherein Umatilla County was plaintiff and Oscar Drumheller and Elizabeth Drumheller, husband and wife, Francis M. Stubblefield and Myrtle D. Stubblefield, husband and wife, were defendants whereby said plaintiff now parties of the second part were ordered and required to construct and maintain a standard stock pass or drive at a point to be designated by the defendants and parties of the first part herein upon the following described property, to-wit:

All that part of the property of Oscar Drumheller and Elizabeth Drumheller, his wife, included within a strip of land forty feet wide being twenty feet on each side of the following described center line as surveyed over and across the East half of Section 26, Township 6 North Range 36 E.W.M.

Beginning at a point in the center of the present county road which point is 709 feet North and 51 feet East of the center of said Section 26, thence South $19^{\circ} 24'$ East a distance of 916.9 feet, thence on a 16° curve to the left, the Central angle of which is $24^{\circ} 40'$ a distance of 154.2 feet to a point in the center of the present county road which point is 295 feet South and 514 feet East of the center of Section 26, township 6 North Range 36, E. W. M., containing 0.98 acres, more or less.

And the said parties of the second part in consideration of said covenants on the part of the said parties of the first part hereinbefore contained, agrees to and with the said parties of the first part that the said parties of the second part will pay to the said parties of the first part the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars upon the execution of this contract in Gold Coin, and the parties of the first part shall have the right to construct one pipe line across and under the roadway upon the above described property of party of the second part, at any time after the execution of this agreement.

WHEREAS this being a regular term of the Umatilla County Court and the said Court being now in regular session, sitting for the transaction of County Business with all members of said Court present.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the month of May, 1925, in the County Court Room at the County Court House in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, for the transaction of County Business, that it is, and is hereby declared to be the intentions of the said County Court to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten and change a highway or road on and over a route as follows:

All that part of the property of W. R. Taylor and Nellie Taylor, his wife in the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, Willamette Meridian. Said parcel of land being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of the East half of Section 19, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W. M.; thence South along the 16th

RESOLUTION

TO ALL PERSONS TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS this court by resolution made and dated April 3rd, 1924, adopted a certain resolution declaring the intention of the said County Court to locate, establish, alter widen, straighten and change a highway or road on or over certain property of one Oscar Drumneller and Elizabeth Drumneller located in the East Half of Section 26, Tp. 6 N.R. 36 E.W.M. in Umatilla County, Oregon. A more particular description of said road being in said resolution contained.

AND WHEREAS it is the desire and intention of said County Court to construct and maintain a stock pass or drive upon a portion of the said road running through said property

And the court at this time desiring to pass a formal resolution declaring its said intention and purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the month of October, 1924, in the County Court room at the County Court house in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, for the transaction of County business, that it be and is hereby declared to be the intention and purpose of said County Court to establish construct and maintain at a point upon the right of way running through the land of said Oscar Drumneller and Elizabeth Drumneller above referred to, to be designated by the said owners and if not so designated, then at a point approximately as indicated upon the map prepared by Lee Shannon and introduced in evidence in the Action brought to condemn said right of way, a standard stock pass or drive having the dimensions of seven feet in height and six feet in width in the clear, constructed of crested timber the posts being crested cedar and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the said right of way is taken, that the Roadmaster of Umatilla County, Oregon, construct said stock pass and drive at the time the said road is constructed and that the same be maintained free of charge to the owner or owners of the adjoining property referred to above.

AND THAT the same be constructed free of charge to said owners.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the district attorney of Umatilla County, Oregon be and he is hereby directed and empowered to make a formal offer and tender to construct and maintain such stock pass or drive in the pending action brought to condemn and appropriate said right of way and to offer in said action that the decree of appropriation of said land contain a covenant and condition that the said stock pass or drive be so constructed and maintained, if the said right of way is taken.

In the matter of locating, establishing altering, widening, straightening and changing of a county road, same being a portion of what is commonly known as the Birch Creek Road in the County of Umatilla and State of Oregon. RESOLUTION

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS there now exists in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, what is known as Birch Creek Road, same being a County road and highway in the aforesaid county and state; and

WHEREAS in order that the said highway may be located, established altered, widened, straightened and change, it is necessary to appropriate certain lands belonging to one Oscar Drumheller and Elizabeth Drumheller, his wife, and

WHEREAS this being a regular term of the Umatilla County Court and the said Court being now in regular session, sitting for the transaction of County business with all members of said court present,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the Month of April 1, 1924, in the County Court room at the County Court house in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon for the transaction of County business, that it is, and is hereby declared to be the intention of the said County Court to locate establish alter, widen, straighten and change a highway or road on and over a route as follows:

All that part of the property of Oscar Drumheller and Elizabeth Drumheller his wife, included within a strip of land forty (40) feet wide being twenty (20) feet on each side of the following described center line as surveyed over and across the east half of Section 26, Township 6 North Range 36 EWM.

Beginning at a point in the center of the present county road which point is 709 feet North and 51 feet east of the center of said Section 26, thence south 19° 24' East a distance of 916.9 feet, thence on a 16° curve to the left, the central angle of which is 34° 40' a distance of 154.2 feet to a point in the center of the present county road which point is 295 feet south and 514 feet east of the center of Section 26, Township 6 North Range 36 EWM.

Contains 0.98 acres more or less:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public necessary for said highway or road is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit: That in order to eliminate the upkeep of two bridges, to make a better grade and to prevent washing out of road, it is essential that the road be built over and across the land hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, be and he is hereby requested to bring such condemnation proceedings as may be necessary to condemn the said property as by law provided, for the purposes hereinabove referred to and that a true copy of this resolution be duly entered in the Commissioners Journal.

In the matter of Auto License fees.

HEREBY ORDERED by the court that all moneys received by the County Treasurer from the State Treasurer for and on account of motor license fees, shall be immediately placed in the General Road Fund of Umatilla County,
