Notice is hereby given that the undersigned House holders Residing in the vicinity of the proposed road herein after mentioned. Will, at the April term in 1887, of the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Umatilla present a Petition asking and praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County Road ^{40 feet wide} as follows to wit:

Commencing on the State line between the State of Oregon and the Territory of Washington at a point 5 chains and 50 links west of where the section line running north and south, between sections 14 and 15 in Township 6 North of Range 35 east W.M. crosses the said State line. Running thence in a southerly direction across the land of R. Mills to the line running between said sections, at a point 80 Rods north eby from the south east corner of said section 14. Thence south on said section line, on the lands of Lewis Winters and John Lewis 80 Rods. Thence south on the section line between sections 22 and 23 in said Township, about three fourths of a Mile, over the lands of O. R. Ballan and the lands belonging to the estate of Alexander Jurgensen Dec'd.
