Now on this day Comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed by this Court to view and report upon the Change in the above mentioned County Road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court to wit: July 23rd 1882 and the viewers having reported favorable upon the Change of said County Road & recommending the establishment of said Change in said Road, and the field notes & Plat of survey having been duly filed & certified by the surveyor appointed to survey the same It is ordered by the Court that said Change in said County Road be established & located as a County Road in accordance with said report & survey filed herein, upon satisfactory proof being filed with the Court that the said Change in said Road has been duly opened a legal width and in all respects made equal to the old road for the convenience of Travellers & that said report of viewers field notes and plat of survey be recorded as by law required and that all that portion of said old road embraced in this Change be vacated.
