FINAL ORDER OF VACATION

Be it remembered that at a regular session of the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, held in the courtroom of said Court in the Temporary Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon, on the 8th day of February, 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., present:

D. R. Cook, County Judge, and J. E. Olinger and Roscoe H. Kelley, County Commissioners, the following proceedings were had:

Whereas, by resolution and order unanimously adopted on the 4th day of January, 1956, it was declared that proceedings to vacate those portions of County Road #163 hereinafter described, would be undertaken, and said proceedings were instituted, and the County Engineer was notified of said proceedings and was ordered and directed to examine said portions of County Road #163 and to make a report in writing on the same as provided by law; and

Whereas, said County Engineer did examine said portion of County Road #163, and on the 4th day of January, 1956, made his report in writing thereon as required by law, and filed said report with the County Clerk of Umatilla County, Oregon, and

Whereas, said notice of hearing was duly given by posting as required by law on the 5th day of January, 1956, which was more than thirty days before the day set for said hearing; and proof that such notice has been given was made by affidavit of the

County Engineer, now on file herein; and,

Whereas, pursuant to said order and notice this matter came on duly to be heard by the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon in the Courtroom of said Court in the Temporary Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon on the 8th day of February 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., at which time and place the said report of the County Engineer was duly heard and considered, and the said resolution instituting said proceeding was duly considered and no objection was made by any person to the vacation of said portion of County Road #163 and,

Whereas, it appears to this Court that said portions of County Road 163 are not now in use by the public, and that they will not be a useful part of the general road system of Umatilla County, Oregon, and it further appears that the public will be benefited by the vacation thereof; and the Court being fully advised in the premises:

It Is Hereby Ordered that the following described portion of County Road #163 of Umatilla County, Oregon, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 18, Township 4 North, Range 36 East, Willamette Meridian; thence running South a distance of 132 feet; thence South 45 degrees East a distance of 1485 feet; thence South 35 degrees East a distance of 396 feet; thence South 56 degrees East a distance of 1452 feet; thence South 48 degrees East a distance of 1122 feet; thence East a distance of 396 feet; thence South 29 degrees East a distance of 990 feet; thence South a distance of 1320 feet; thence South 25 degrees East a distance of 660 feet; thence South 60 degrees East a distance of 990 Feet; thence South 86 degrees East a distance of 2178 feet; thence South 35 degrees East a distance of 1254 feet; thence South 85 degrees East a distance of 198 feet; thence South 35 degrees East a distance of 462 feet; thence South 35 degrees East a distance of 462 feet; thence South 62 degrees East a distance of 1827 feet more or less to a point intersecting the section line common to Sections 28 and 29, Township 4North, Range 36 East, Willamette Meridian.
