ROAD NOTICE

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the Undersigned, who are freeholders of said County and State, and reside in the road district or districts of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the August term, 1918, of said County Court, to-wit: On the 8th day of August 1918, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing-----

at a point on the line running North and South through the center of the East Half of Section ~~THREE~~ ^{THREE} in Township FIVE North, Range THIRTY-FIVE E.W. M., ONE HUNDRED and SEVENTY-FIVE rods ^{being the eastern boundary line of the proposed road} North of the South line of said Section and Township; running thence due East SEVEN feet, running thence North SEVEN feet East of, and parallel to, the said line which runs North and South through the center of the East Half of said Section NINETY rods more or less, to the ~~South-Westerly side of the County Road, now running through said Section and Township,~~ ^{and increasing the width} thence North-Westerly along the South-Westerly side of said County Road as now located, to a point THIRTY-THREE feet due West of the ~~said line running North and South through the center of the East Half of said Section and Township;~~ ^{and on the eastern boundary of said road} thence South THIRTY-THREE feet West of and parallel to said North and South line to a point due West of the point of beginning; thence THIRTY-THREE feet due East to the point of beginning, all in Umatilla County and State of Oregon

Said road to be FORTY feet wide
