

In the matter of County Road commencing at the terminus of Road Survey no. 385, for Umatilla County, Oregon and running th. up the grade on Road Survey #348 in said County to its head at intersection of the line running E & W th. through the center of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Rec 8 in T3 N. R. 36 E; th. E along E & W line, about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile th. N. Easterly on the route recommended by one of your Hon. body May 2d, 1894, to intersect the line running N & S through E $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Rec 8 as near as may be practicable; thence continuing up and on the N side of Wild Horse Creek on most practicable route to intersect said road survey #348, at or near the line between Rec 8 & 9 in said T^h th. E on N side of Wild Horse Creek as near as practicable on Survey 348 to the Cor of Recs 10, 11, 14, and 15 in said T^h; th. S on line bet. Recs 14, and 15 as near as practicable $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and terminate. Then con. at a point on the foregoing described route at its intersection with a N & S line passing through the center of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Rec 8 and running thence N on said N & S line as near as practicable to intersect the head of a road grade at or near the $\frac{1}{16}$ sec corner on the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of line bet Recs 5 & 8 in said T^h, th. following said grade to its terminus at or near a point on the N & S line running through the center of the E half of Rec 5 in said T^h; th. N. on said N & S line and terminate at the initial point of said road Survey #348. Said Road to be forty feet wide.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed at the July term, 1894, of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a County road for final hearing, the same having been, upon a previous day of this term of this Court, to-wit: the Sept term, 1894, and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plat of survey having been duly filed and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said Viewers field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and that the Supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
