Now on this day comes the report of Abe Miller, J. M. Hemphill and A. Waugh the viewers heretofore appointed at the July 1883 term of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County road, for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court, to-wit September term 1883, and the viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance on file against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the report of said viewers, field notes, and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required

Bailey be vacated
