In the Matter of Surrendering Jurisdiction over a Portion of a County Road within the Corporate Limits of the City of Weston, Oregon.)

ORDER OFFERING TO SURRENDER JURISDICTION OVER PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD

THIS MATTER came on for hearing on the 4th. day of May, 1953, before the Honorable James H. Sturgis, County Judge; Jasper E. Olinger, County Commissioner; Claude Meyers, County Commissioner; Jessie M. Bell, County Clerk; Roy E. Johnson, County Sheriff and George H. Corey, District Attorney, sitting for the transaction of county business, and

It appearing that a portion of Umatilla County Road No. 303 lies within the corporate limits of the City of Weston, Oregon, an incorporated city, and

It further appearing that the Common Council is the governing body of said city and has deemed it necessary and expedient and for the best interests of said city to acquire jurisdiction over such county road as is situated within the corporate limits of said city to the same extent as it has over other public streets and alleys of said city, and has by resolution dated January 7, 1953, requested the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, to surrender jurisdiction of the hereinafter described portion of said road to the City of Weston, Oregon, and

It further appearing that it is deemed necessary and expedient and for the best interests of the county to surrender jurisdiction over that portion of said county road within the corporate limits of the City of Weston, Oregon, to the City of Weston, Oregon, and

It further appearing that this is the time and place set for a public hearing pursuant to notice duly and regularly posted in accordance with law, certificate of said posting having been heretofore filed herein, for a public hearing to hear said matter and to consider any objections or testimony offered by any person interested and determine whether it is necessary or expedient or for the best interest of Umatilla County, Oregon to surrender jurisdiction over the portion of such county road herein described to the City of Weston, Oregon, and to make such orders and determinations as may be necessary in the premises, and

It further appearing that no objections have been raised and that all testimony is favorable to the surrender of jurisdiction over said county road and that it is necessary and expedient and for the best interests of the county to take such action, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

It is hereby ORDERED and the Court does find and determine that it is necessary, expedient and for the best interests of Umatilla County, Oregon, to surrender jurisdiction over that portion of the county road lying within the corporate limits of the City of Weston, Oregon, as is hereafter described, to the City of Weston, Oregon, to-wit:

Road No. 303 located in North City limits of Weston, beginning at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 15, Township 4 North, Range 35, E.W.M. Thence West a distance of 130.0 feet to Engineers Station 1 plus 30.0 P.C. Thence on 286.48 foot Radius Curve to the Right (the long chord of which bears North 75° 58' West a distance of 138.77 feet) the arc distance which is 140.17 feet to Engineers Station 2 plus 70.16 P.T. Thence North 61° 58' West a distance of 9.8 feet to Engineers Station 2 plus 79.96 P.C. Thence on a 818.51 foot Radius Curve to the Right (the long chord of which bears North 54° 58' West a distance of 199.50 feet) the Arc distance which is 200.0 feet to Engineers Station 4 plus 79.96 P.T. Thence North 47° 58' West a distance 11.6 feet to Engineers Station 5 plus 91.56 P.C. Thence on a 954.93 foot Radius Curve to the Right (the long chord of which bears North 36° 50' 30" West a distance of 368.51 feet) the Arc distance which is 370.83 feet to Engineers Station 9 plus 62.39 P.T. Thence North 25° 43' West a distance of 312.03 feet to Engineers Station 12 plus 74.42 P.C. Thence on a 112.34 foot Radius Curve to the left (the long chord which bears North 51° 07' 45" West 96.42 feet) the Arc distance which is 99.65 feet to Engineers Station 13 plus 74.07 P.T. Thence North 76° 32' 30" West a distance of 5.12 feet to Engineers Station 13 plus 79.19 feet P.C. Thence on a 133.25 foot Radius Curve to the Right (the long chord of which bears North 54° 58' West a distance 98.0 feet) the Arc distance which is 100.35 feet to Engineers Station 14 plus 79.54 P.T. Thence North 33° 23' 30" west a distance of 301.06 feet to angle point Engineers Station 17 plus 80.6. Thence North 32° 01' 30" West a distance of 172.0 feet to Engineers Station 19 plus 52.6 P.O.T. Said point intersecting East and West center line of Southwest Quarter of Section 15, Township 4 North, Range 35, E.W.M.

It is further ORDERED that the surrender of jurisdiction to the City of Weston, Oregon, is by this order hereby offered to the City of Weston, Oregon, and in the event that the City of Weston, Oregon shall, by and through its Common Council, accept such offer within sixty (60) days from date hereof by appropriate ordinance or resolution or other municipal legislation, then upon legal adoption of such ordinance, resolution or other appropriate municipal legislation the jurisdiction of said Umatilla County, Oregon, over such county road for its improvement, construction, maintenance and repair shall cease and determine, and the full and absolute jurisdiction over the same for all such purposes and the levying and collection of assessments therefor shall vest in the said City of Weston, Oregon, and such city shall have the same control, power and jurisdiction over the same as by its Charter and the laws of the State of Oregon are given or granted it over any of the public streets and alleys of such city, and

It is further ORDERED that a certified copy of this order shall be by the County Clerk of Umatilla County, Oregon, transmitted by registered mail to the City of Weston, Oregon, on date hereof, and

It is further ORDERED that this order be entered herein nunc pro tunc as of the 4th. day of May, 1953.
