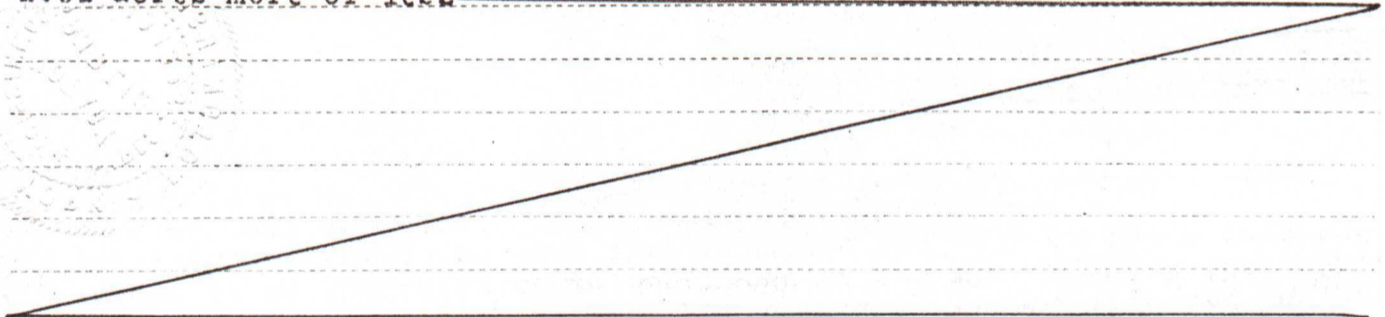

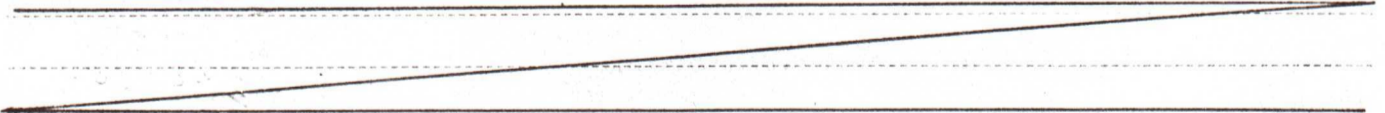

Nellie Taylor, his wife, in the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 4 North, Range 35 E.W.M., said parcel of land being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of the East Half of Section 19, Township 4 North Range 35 E.W.M., thence South along the Section line 2249 feet; thence North 20°36' West 00 feet; thence on a 603 foot radius curve to the right 216.9 feet; thence North 1858.0 feet; thence on a 161.0 foot radius curve to the left 252.9 feet; thence North 30 feet thence East 191.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.01 acres more or less
