paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in

the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on

each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the North-

east Quarter of Section 30 and the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W.M. Said center line being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a point known and designated as Station 28 / 05.2 of the said Market Road survey, which point is 1013 feet west of the Northwest corner of said Section 30, thence South 40 04' East, 1769.5 feet, thence on a 573.0 feet radius curve to the right 198.3 feet, thence South 20 14' East, 917.9 feet to Station 56 / 91, which point is 230 feet North and 2200 feet west of the Center of Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

Beginning at Station of the Highway Survey
