and other valuable consideration paid to them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across Sections

29 and 32, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W.M. Said center line being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point known and designated as Station 74 / 49.0, which point is on the north line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W.M. and approximately 1310 feet

North and 1245 feet East of the Southwest Corner of said Section 29, thence South 35° 54' East, 6303 feet to a point known and designated as Station 137 / 52.0, which point is on the south line of Lot No. 3, Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 35 East, W.M. and

approximately 1320 feet North and 662 feet West of the Southeast Corner of said Section 32. Contains 8.68 acres more or less, which Station is approximately feet and feet of the Corner
