

Field Notes of the Survey of the
 County road from Dentons to
 head of Lamer Hollow,
 Commence at the Quarter section corner
 between Sections 29 & 30 Town of N. Range
 35 East, Q4 21° East

Measure North 14 rods
 Thence East 22 rods to right bank of
 Wild Horse Creek.

Set an Alder post for initial point
 from which an alder tree four inches
 in diameter bears S 75° W. distance 40 links
 from an Alder three inches in diameter
 bears N 72° W. 76 links distant,
 from thence on said road as follows

1	South	3,50	on line bet. Purdy and Copock's line $\frac{1}{4}$ mile East of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

4	S 52° E	4,00	To grade stake in S. B. Purdy's grain field
5	N 60° E	3,00	To $\frac{1}{4}$ sec line bet. the farms of Purdy & Copock East set on said center line at Eighty chains set a Tamarac Post in mound of Earth marked R I M
6	East	94,14	To terminus of road, planted a Tamarac Stake, at the intersection of this road with the County road leading to the

head of Lamar Hollows.
