Estate to wit - a strip of land for County road purposes. 40 feet in width, being a part of the NE<sup>4</sup> sec 1 Tp. 3. North of Range 35 E. W. M. described as follows. - Beginning at a stake, 192 feet from the West bank of Pine Creek and running in a southeasterly direction 120 feet to the West bank of said Pine Creek thence 270 feet in a northeasterly direction to a point intersecting the present County road, 200 feet from the east bank of Pine Creek.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining - and also all their Estate right title and interest, at law and Equity therein or thereto including dower and right of dower, to have and to hold the same to the said Umatilla County, its heirs and assigns forever and we William & Margaret J. Linnallen do covenant with the said Umatilla County, and its legal representatives forever, that the said real estate is free from all incumbrances and that we, will and our heirs, Executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same unto the said County its heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, whomsoever.
