**WHEREAS,** the above referenced matter came before the Board of Commissioners on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2002, in a public hearing and again on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2002, in a continuation of the April 17<sup>th</sup> public hearing, and

**WHEREAS,** the Board, after hearing testimony both for and against the vacation determined it to be in the Public interest to deny the petition for vacation based on the possible future benefits of preserving the road right-of-way, and

**WHEREAS,** in lieu of vacating the right-of-way, the Board, pursuant to ORS 368.056, is willing to issue a permit to the Petitioners to construct a gate near the intersection of Schubert Road and Hudson Bay Road and/or at any other location on the road for the purpose of limiting access to Petitioners' property, and

**WHEREAS,** the Board, pursuant to ORS 810.030, has directed the Public Works Department to install a "ROAD CLOSED...AUTHORIZED VEHICLES ONLY" sign near the intersection of Schubert Road and Hudson Bay Road to further aid the Petitioners in limiting access to their property and to protect the safety of the public;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Board of County Commissioners hereby orders that the vacation petition from R. G. and Betty Schubert be denied.
