IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR UMATILLA COUNTY

JUNE TERM, 1928, WEDNESDAY JUDICIAL DAY JUNE 6, 1928

In the matter of the County Road :
Petitioned for by Paul Mack, et :
al, commencing in Section 17, 6 : ROAD No. 874
N. 37. :

Now on this day there is presented to the Court, the Petition of Paul Mack and thirteen other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein the hereinafter described and proposed County road is to be laid out, praying this Court to cause to be laid out and established, a County road commencing at a point near the middle of the East line of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 17, said point of beginning being also at the point where the present county road, running northerly angles to the left from the one sixteenth section line, thence running southeasterly up the North Cottonwood Canyon through the east half of the southeast quarter of Section 17 and across Sections 20, 21, 22, 27, 26, 25 and 36, all in township 6 North, Range 37 East, W.M. and thence into Section 31, township 6 North, Range 38 East W.M. to a connection with the old Meadows road, thence Southerly following the old Meadows road through Sections 6 and 7 to connect with the County Road known as the Government road at the point where the said county road intersects the Westline of Section 7, all in township 5 north, range 38 East, W.M., and to be sixty feet wide.

AND THE COURT FINDS that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said proposed road, and also by the posting of a notice on the bulletin board at the West entrance of the County Courthouse in Pendleton, Oregon, the same being the place of holding the County Court. That each and all of said notices were securely posted in a public place, and in plain view of the public for full 30 days prior to the presentation of said Petition to this court.

AND all matters appearing regular, and there being no objections on file, it is HEREBY ORDERED that H.M. Cockburn, T.C. Elliott and L.J. Shannon be and they are hereby appointed as a board of county road viewers to view and report upon said proposed road; and that said viewers meet at the beginning point of said proposed road on the 11th day of June, 1928, or if unable to meet on that day, then within ten days thereafter and proceed to view and survey if necessary, and report upon said proposed road at the next regular term of this court.

In the matter of vacating :
a portion of County Road :
in Sec. 35, T. 5 N.R. 34 : ORDER VACATING SAID ROAD 204
E.W.M., petitioned for by :
M.W. Hansell, et al :

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard, this being the time and term for the final decision of the Court upon said matter, and it appearing that due and lawful notice of the final hearing herein has been given by the posting of three certified copies of the order of the court made and entered on the 4th day of April, 1928, in three public places in the vicinity of said road which is proposed to be vacated, and also by the posting of a certified copy of such Order on the bulletin board at the west door of the County courthouse in Pendleton, Oregon, the same being the place of holding the County Court. That each and all of said notices were posted full 30 days prior to the date of hearing on said matter; and that due proof of the posting of such notices or orders is on file herein. And it appearing that no objections has been made or filed to such proposed vacation, and it appearing that said road so proposed to be vacated is not useful as a part of the general road system of Umatilla County, Oregon, and it appearing that the public will be benefited by such vacation, and that such road will not, in the future, be useful as a part of the general road system, and is not of sufficient public benefit to warrant the same being maintained by the County,

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that said road, commencing at the center of section 35, tp. 5 North, Range 34 E.W.M. and running thence East 1/2 mile more or less to the eastern boundary of said section 35, tp. 5 N.R. 34 is useless, dangerous and burdensome to maintain, is of no value to individuals, or to the general public, and is useless as a part of the road system of Umatilla County, and the same is hereby vacated.
