In the Matter of County Road to be vacated, petitioned for by W J Dorran, et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on to be considered, upon the report of the Board of County road-viewers, heretofore instructed at the April 1912 term of this court to view, survey and report upon said road which is proposed to be vacated It is hereby ordered, that further consideration of this matter be and is hereby continued until the June 1912 term of this court.

In the matter of the report of the Board of County road-viewers upon vacating a portion of County Road No. 717.

ROAD NO. 717

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard, upon the report of the Board of county road-viewers heretofore instructed at the April 1912 term of this court to view, survey and report upon the vacating of a portion of County road No. 717 as follows: Commencing at a point, where County road No. 717 crosses the North line of Section 17 Tp 5 North Range 34 E W M., which said point is 76 rods more or less West of the Northeast corner of said Sec. 17, thence running South and southeasterly along said road No. 717 a distance of 187 rods, more or less ending at a point where said County road No. 717 intersects the east line of said Sec. 17, which point is 10 rods more or less North of the Southeast corner of said Sec. 17, for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 2nd, 1912 and publicly read the second time on May 3rd, 1912, and said Board of County road-viewers have recommended that since proposed County road No. 739 was found not to be practical, that said road No. 717 which is proposed to be vacated, will be needed for highway purposes and have therefore recommended that said route be not vacated

It is therefore hereby ORDERED by the court, that said report of the Board of County road-viewers be approved, that said petition be denied and dismissed and that the bondsmen, to-wit: C H Downing, Ida E Downing and C A Barrett, pay to Umatilla County the amount of the costs incurred by the reason of such survey, to-wit: the sum of \$3.40.

In the Matter of the Report of the Board of County road-viewers on County road No. 735.

ROAD NO. 735

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County road-viewers heretofore instructed at the February 1912 term of this court to view, survey, stake and layout said proposed road No. 735 petitioned for as follows: Commencing at the corner which is common to Section 29, 30, 31 and 32 Tp 4 N. R. 35 E W M run thence South on line between said sections 31 and 32, in said township and range and continuing South between sections 5 and 6, 7 and 8, 17 and 18, 19 and 20, in Tp 3 N. R. 35, and to be 50 ft. wide as a county road for final hearing, the

same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 2nd, 1912, and publicly read the second time on May 3rd, 1912, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the said board of County road-viewers having reported favorably and recommended that that portion of said proposed road from the beginning point to a point of said road South 1.50 chains from the quarter section corner between sections 17 and 18, Tp 3 N. R. 35, be declared and established a public highway of Umatilla County, and the court finds that said petition is duly and regularly signed by 12 freeholders who are residents of the road district wherein said proposed road is to be laid out and established and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said petition or report.

It is hereby ordered, that said report of the Board of County road-viewers be approved and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.

ROAD NO. 737.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County road-viewers heretofore instructed at the April 1912 term of this court to view, survey, stake and layout said proposed road No. 737 petitioned for as follows: Commencing at a point 200 ft. South of the Northeast corner NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31, Tp 4 N. R. 29; thence south a distance of  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, less 200 ft. to the Southwest corner SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 31 Tp 4 N. R. 29, thence East along the quarter section line,  $\frac{3}{4}$  of 1 mile to the line running North and South between Sections 31 and 32, said township and range and to be 40 ft. wide as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read upon two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 2nd, 1912, and publicly read the second time on May 3rd, 1912, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the said Board of county road-viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be declared and established a public highway of Umatilla County and the court finds that the said petition filed herein being duly and regularly signed by more than 12 freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein said proposed road is to be laid out and established and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said petition or report.

It is therefore hereby ORDERED that said report of the Board of County road-viewers be approved and that said plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes in Umatilla County and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use when the damage to the property owners along said route by reason of the establishment of said road as follows: Susan A White, in the sum of \$275.00; have been paid by the petitioners.

ROAD NO. 738

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County road-viewers heretofore instructed at the April 1912 term of this court, to view, survey, stake and layout, said proposed road No. 738, petitioned for as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 29, Tp 6 North, R. 35 E W M and run from thence a distance of  $\frac{1}{4}$  miles to the Northeast corner of Sec. 28, said township and range and to be 40 ft wide as a County road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read upon two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 2nd, 1912, and publicly read the second time on May 3rd, 1912, and the said field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the said Board of county road-viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be declared and established a public highway of Umatilla County and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, and that said petition is duly and regularly signed by more than 12 freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts, wherein said proposed road is to be established and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said petition or report.

It is hereby ORDERED that said report of the Board of County road viewers, be approved and that said plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use when the damages to the property owners along said route by reason of the establishment of said road as follows: X G Crow, in the sum of \$150.00 and G W Smiley in the sum of \$20.00, have been paid by the petitioners.
