each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the North-east Quarter of Section 4, T. 3 N. R. 34 E. W.M. Said center line being more particularly described as follows; Begining at a point known and designated as Station 13 on the said road survey, which point is approximately 1320 feet South and 1900 feet East of the Quarter Section corner on the North side of Said Section 4, thence North 2° 00' East, 282.3 feet, thence on a 573.0 feet radius curve to the left, thence North 45° 56' West, 221 feet, thence on a 716.3 feet radius curve to the right, 398.1 feet, thence North 14° 05' West, 241.3 feet to a point known and designated as Station 28 of the said survey which point is approximately 1287 feet East of the above described Quarter Section Corner on the North side of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 34 East, W.M.
