FINAL ORDER OF VACATION

Be it remembered that at a regular session of the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, held in the courtroom of said Court in the Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon, on the 9th day of May, 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A. M., present:

D. R. Cook, County Judge, and J. E. Olinger and Roscoe H. Kelley, County Commissioners, the following proceedings were had:

Whereas, by resolution and order unanimously adopted on the 1st day of February, 1956, it was declared that proceedings to vacate those portions of County Road #367 hereinafter described, would be undertaken, and said proceedings were instituted, and the County Engineer was notified of said proceedings and was ordered and directed to examine said portions of County Road #367 and to make a report in writing on the same as provided by law; and

Whereas, said County Engineer did examine said portion of County Road #367, and on the 8th day of February, 1956, made his report in writing thereon as required by law, and filed said report with the County Clerk of Umatilla County, Oregon, and

Whereas, said notice of hearing was duly given by posting as required by law on the 9th day of February, 1956, which was more than thirty days before the day set for said hearing; and proof that such notice has been given was made by affidavit of the County Engineer, now on file herein; and,

Whereas, pursuant to said order and notice this matter came on

duly to be heard by the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon in the Courtroom of said Court in the Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon, on the 9th day of May, 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., at which time and place the said report of the County Engineer was duly heard and considered, and the said resolution instituting said proceeding was duly considered and no objection was made by any person to the vacation of said portion of County Road #367 and,

Whereas, it appears to this Court that said portions of County Road #367 are not now in use by the public, and that they will not be a useful part of the general road system of Umatilla County, Oregon, and it further appears that the public will be benefited by the vacation thereof; and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

It Is Hereby Ordered that the following described portion of County Road #367 of Umatilla County, Oregon, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the section line common to Sections 23 and 26, Township 3 North, Range 33 East, Willamette Meridian, where the section line intersects the North right-of-way of the Washington-Oregon Highway No. 11; thence in a westerly direction on the above described section line to a point 30 feet east of the North and South quarter line of Sections 23 and 26, Township 3 North, Range 33 East, Willamette Meridian. The right-of-way of Road #367 being 30 feet each side of the above described line.

It Is Further Ordered that this Order be entered in the Journal of this Court.
