TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON
FOR UMATILLA COUNTY:

We, the undersigned board of County Road Viewers heretofore
instructed to view the above mentioned proposed road submit the
following report;

Pursuant to your order, we met at the point of beginning of
the above mentioned proposed road on the 14th day of July, 1930
and having qualified as viewers proceeded to view the proposed road.

We find the road as located and laid out to be a feasible
and necessary one and a benefit to the public, therefore, we
respectfully recommend that it be opened and established as a
County Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

An agreement now exists between the County Court and A. Lei-
singer in which he received compensation for the right of way and,
whereas fencing was furnished between Station 0/50 and Station
24/00, we find that he is further damaged in the amount of nothing.

Otis Hampton representing the Estate of S.A. Hampton has
received compensation to cover damages and fencing for crossing
land of the said estate in the North East quarter of Section 27,
Township 5, North Range 32, E W M, in the sum of \$250.00, and we
find that he is further damaged in the sum of nothing.

With this difference we recommend that the right of way be
fenced with a three wire barb wire fence, using all the material
that is available from the old fence, and replacing the balance
with new wire and posts.

We find that none of the lands through which this road
will be established will be made less valuable.
