

To the Hon. County Court, for
Umatilla County, Oregon.

I herewith submit the field
notes and plat of the change in
County road No. 164 as surveyed by me
July 18th, 1884.

I met in the town of Adams in
the above named County and state, Wm.
H. Ferguson, J. T. Adams and A. McKenzie,
whom I qualified as viewers, Wm.
Holdman and Wm. Lucy whom I qual-
ified as chain-bearers, and G. W. Buchanan,
whom I qualified as marker on the date
above given, and forthwith proceeded to
execute your order to survey out change
in County road No. 164 of which the fol-
lowing are the field notes:—

250 feet I commence 580 feet north of the center
of section 4. T. 3 N. R. 34 E. Set fir post
4x4x42 inches, marked R on east side in
mound 4x4x1 1/2 feet, and run east
along south limit of road to west line
of Morrison street in the town of Adams.
410 ft Set stake 2x2x18 inches marked AR and
run south, along west limit of road,
to center of Commercial street, in the
town of Adams. Set stake 2x2x18 inches,
marked AR, and run east, along the

center of road
2560 ft to center of channel of Wild Horse Creek.
Set fir post 4x4x42 inches on west bank
of creek:- post marked R on west side,
and a mound raised 4x4x1 1/2 feet.
Whole distance 3220 feet, surface
sloping toward east, no rock nor trees.
