It is therefore ordered by the Court that said change be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and the report of said viewers, field notes^{and} plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose District said road runs, open the same for public use.

In the matter of Liquor } No 93
License of A. R. Jack }

Now on this day comes the petition of the legal voters of Umatilla Precinct, Umatilla County, Oregon praying the Court to grant a License to A. R. Jack to sell spirituous liquors in less quantities than one quart at his place of business in Umatilla for the period of "One Year" and it appearing to the Court from the proofs^{and} papers filed herein that the law has been fully complied with in the matter by the posting of notices as by law required^{and} a good^{and} sufficient bond given, and there being no remonstrance on file against said petition,

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the Clerk of this Court issue a License to A. R. Jack to sell spirituous liquors in less quantities than one quart at his place of business at Umatilla, in Umatilla Precinct, Umatilla County, Oregon for the period of "One Year" from the 15th day of April 1885^{and} ending April 15th 1886.
