

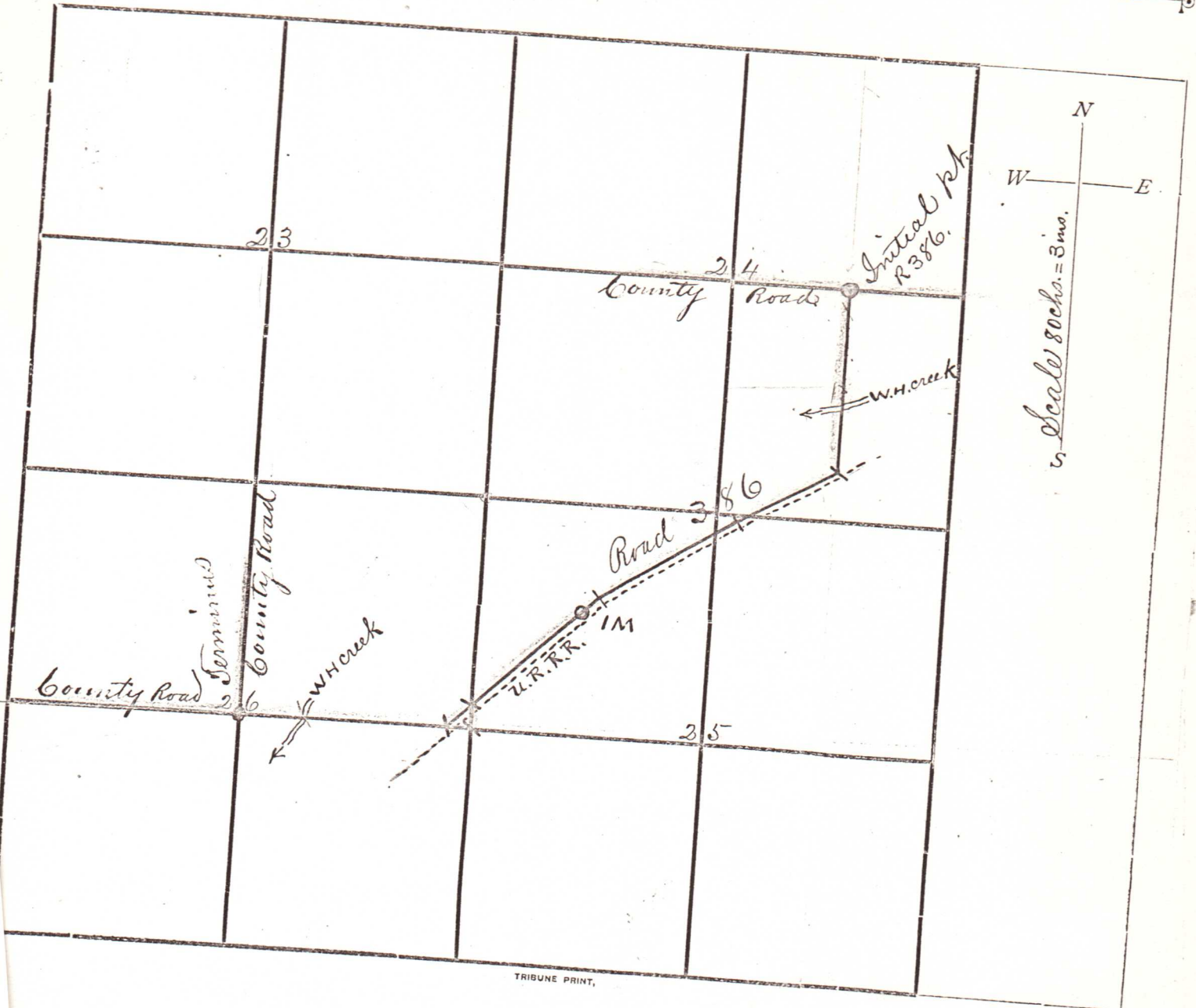
LAWS OF OREGON, CHAPTER LVI, § 13.

"County surveyor shall be allowed fees for their services as follows:
 For every survey, five dollars; for every chain over eighty chains, five cents per chain lineal measure; for calculating the quantity of each tract of land not divided, one dollar; for making each plat, fifty cents; for recording plat and certificate, one dollar; for each copy of plat and certificate, fifty cents; for traveling to and from place of survey, ten cents per mile; provided, that all expenses of chain-carriers and markers shall be paid by the person at whose request the survey is made."
