**RESOLUTION.**

County Road No. 910

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described road, highway or part thereof, is useless as a part of the general road system, and/or dang-  
erous, and/or burdensome to maintain, and that the public will be benefitted by its vacation, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that said road, highway or part thereof, be vacated by resolution of this court, and

WHEREAS, the termini of the said road or highway, or part thereof, proposed to be vacated is as follows, to-wit:

A 30 foot right-of-way, being 15 feet on each side of the center line  
over and across a portion of Sections 1 and 2, Township 2, North Range  
27, E.W.M., being particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point  
which is 2702.6 feet South of and 1187.5 feet West of the NE corner of  
Sec. 1, Twp. 2, North Range 27, E.W.M., the said point being adjacent to and  
on the West edge of the pavement of State Secondary Highway No. 320, thence  
North 86 degrees, 23 minutes West 346.2 feet; thence South 87 degrees, 39  
minutes West 2706.1 feet; thence North 82 degrees, 34 minutes West 344.9  
feet; thence South 87 degrees, 11 minutes West 1060.1 feet; thence North  
74 degrees, 38 minutes West 39.9 feet; thence North 59 degrees, 30 minutes  
West 387.8 feet; thence North 72 degrees, 54 minutes West 765 feet to the  
center of road No. 116, the last defined point being located 2354 feet  
South of and 6840.6 feet West of the point of beginning of this survey.

The above being the actual survey of the land described in the  
general description as set forth in the deed from Katherine Stanfield to  
Umatilla County, recorded in Book 142, Page 399 of the Deed Records of  
Umatilla County, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the above entitled court sitting for transaction of County business, at the regular  
term of said court for the month of September A. D. 1948 in the County Court Room in the County Court  
House, in Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, that proceedings to vacate said road or highway or part thereof be undertaken, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public necessity for the vacation of said road or highway is hereby declared to exist for  
the following reasons, to-wit: The maintenance would be an excessive burden on the County

and,  
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forthwith served upon the County Surveyor  
upon receipt of which notice the said Surveyor, be and he is hereby ORDERED to examine the above described road,  
highway or part thereof, and report to this court in writing on the same his opinion as to whether the said road, highway or part thereof  
should be vacated, whether the same is in use or has been in use, whether it will be advisable to preserve the same for a general road system  
in the future, whether the public will be benefitted by the vacation, and all other facts, matters and things which will be of importance to the  
said Court, and cause the said report upon its completion to be filed with the County Clerk of said County and State.
