

Pendleton, Oregon. Aug. the 14th 1897

To the Honorable County Court
For Umatilla County Oregon
Gentlemen

In the matter of the Resurvey of County
Road No. 313 at Stanton Station in Waweyelo Canyon,
beg liep to report that on August the 2nd 1897
I made a resurvey from the 2 mile Post on said Road
following the rout as per Field Notes now on record
in the County Clerks Office setting centers and side
stakes 30 feet on each side of center of Road. from a
Point opposite the South End of side track of W. & C. R. R.
North to the line between Secs 9 & 16 $42\frac{32}{100}$ rods North
of Platform at North end of Elevators and find that Mr. J. I.
Joy. (The Supervisor) has a portion of the county Road
under fence for a distance of 68 rods and a part
of this distance the whole 60 feet of road is under fence.
