In the Matter of Accepting  
Deed of O. W. R. & N. Co.

Now on this day there is presented to the Court a deed of O. W. R. & N. Co. to Umatilla County for a strip of land sixty feet in width, being 30 feet in width on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at the quarter corner in the east line of said section; thence west along the south line of the subdivision aforesaid, a distance of seven hundred twenty four and sixty three hundredths (724.63) feet to a point in the southwesterly line of the right of way of said Navigation company; thence North 41° 36' West on a line parallel with and distant one hundred (100) feet measured at right angles southwesterly from the center line of the main track of said Navigation Company's railroad, as same is constructed and operated over and across the subdivision aforesaid, a distance of five hundred eighty one (581) feet to a point, the initial point of this description; thence South 3° 24' West, a distance of two hundred forty one and seven tenths (241.7) feet, more or less, to a point which is two hundred seventy one (271) feet, measured at right angles southwesterly from the center line of the main track of said Navigation Company's railroad aforesaid; thence South 41° 36' East parallel with and distant two hundred seventy one (271) feet, measured at right angles southwesterly from the center line of the main track aforesaid to a point in the southerly line of the subdivision aforesaid.
