NOTICE OF INTENT TO VACATE  
RESOLUTION

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described road, highway or part thereof, is useless as a part of the general road system, and/or dangerous, and/or burdensome to maintain, and that the public will be benefited by its vacation, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that said road, highway or part thereof, be vacated by resolution of this court, and

WHEREAS, the termini of the said road or highway, or part thereof, proposed to be vacated is as follows, to-wit:

Road from a point where the said Road No. 124 intersects County Road No. 908 between Sections 9 and 16, Twp. 5 N., Rge. 33 E.W.M.; all of that part easterly of said intersection between Sections 9 and 16, and all of that part between Sections 9 and 10, all in Twp. 5 N., Rge. 33 E.W.M., near Stanton Station.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the above-entitled court sitting for transaction of County business, at the regular term of said court for the month of Feb, A.D., 1964, in the County Court Room in the County Court House, in Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, that proceedings to vacate said road or highway or part thereof be undertaken, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public necessity for the vacation of said road or highway is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit: That the said road is burdensome to maintain and is no longer necessary to the general road system of Umatilla County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forthwith served upon the Roadmaster upon receipt of which notice the said Roadmaster be, and he is hereby ORDERED to examine the above described road, highway or part thereof, and report to this court in writing on the same his opinion as to whether the said road, highway or part thereof should be vacated, whether the same is in use or has been in use, whether it will be advisable to preserve the same for a general road system in the future, whether the public will be benefited by the vacation, and all other facts, matters and things which will be of importance to the said Court, and cause the said report upon its completion to be filed with the County Clerk of said County and State.
