To All Persons Whom it May Concern :

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the May term 1897 of said County Court, to-wit : on the 4 day of May 1897, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit :

Commencing at the south west corner of Sec. Two (2). Tn. Township five (5) N. R. 32. E. W. M.  
Thence running North on Section line to half Sec. corner of <sup>said section</sup> Twenty six (26) Twp. Six (6) N. Range, Thirty two (32) E. W. M.  
Thence East one half mile to center of <sup>section</sup> Twenty six (26)  
Thence North about three fourths of a mile, to canyon. Thence down canyon, and around the hill on the most practicable route to Canon station, on the Washington and Columbia River R. R.  
Said road to follow said lines as near as practicable
