In the Matter of the Petition of J W Tabor for a County road commencing at NW corner SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 22, Tp 5 N. R. 29, E W M.

Now on this day there is presented to the court the petition of J W Tabor and 17 other freeholders of the road district or road districts wherein the hereinafter described and proposed county road is desired to be located, praying this court to lay out and establish a county road commencing at the Northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 22, Tp 5 N. R. 29, E W M., thence in a Northeasterly direction and terminating at or near the center of the Southwest quarter of sec. 12, said township and range, and the court having referred said matter to the District Attorney who disapproves said petition on the ground of insufficient description to the effect that the terminating point of said proposed road is insufficiently described, and the court having duly considered the matter It is hereby ORDERED that said petition be and is hereby disapproved and denied.

In the Matter of the Report of the Board of County road-viewers.

ROAD NO. 736.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road-viewers heretofore instructed at the April 1912 term of this court, to view, survey, stake and report upon said proposed road No. 736, commencing at the Southeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 27, Tp 6 N. R. 32, E W M., and run thence North one-half mile to the Northeast corner of said Sec. 27, thence West one-half mile to the Northwest corner NE $\frac{1}{4}$  said Sec. 27, and to be 40 feet wide as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on May 2nd, 1912, and publicly read the second time on May 3rd, 1912, and continued until this time. And the said Board of county road-viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a county road of Umatilla County, and the said plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report and the court being satisfied that said road is of sufficient public utility

It is therefore, hereby ORDERED that said report of the Board of County road-viewers be approved and that said road be declared a public highway of Umatilla County, and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plat and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.

In the Matter of County Warrant No. 358, Series 89 drawn in favor of O C Rinker.

Now on this day this matter coming on for hearing, and the court being advised that J L McKenzie the person for whom the Stone River Post No. 60 G.A.R. had applied for relief was a person of sufficient means to care for himself and was not a person destitute or in need of assistance from the County,

It is, therefore hereby, ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that warrant No. 358, Series 89, drawn in favor of O C Rinker be cancelled and the County Clerk is hereby ordered to cancel said warrant.
