

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the quarter-section corner on the section line between Sections 3 and 4, in Township 5, North of Range 32, E.W.M.; running thence North two miles and a half to the South-west corner of Section 22, in Township 6, North of Range 32, E.W.M.; thence at right angles East along the section line upon the present travelled road one-half mile, to the quarter-section corner on the South line of said Section 22; thence at right angles North one-half mile to the center of said Section 22; thence North-easterly down the canon, across the North-east quarter of said Section 22, on the most practicable route down said canon, to the ware-house at Canon Station on the line of the Washington and Columbia River Railroad, where said station is located in the South-west quarter of Section 14, Township 6, N. of Range 32 E.W.M.

Said road to be 40 feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
