to view & survey said proposed Road and that they report
their doings ^{through} to this Court at its Jan'y Term 1882 and that they
meet at the point of commencement of said Road on the
7th day of October AD 1881 and duly qualify before entering
upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers
appointed to view & report upon the location of the above mentioned
Road as a County Road for final hearing the same having
been read on a previous day of this term of this Court to wit
Sept 12th 1881 and the viewers having reported favorably and
recommending the establishment of the same as a county Road
& there being no remonstrances on file against said Road & the
filed notes & plat of survey being duly on file & certified by
the surveyor appointed to survey the same
It is therefore ordered by the Court that said Road be
established as a County Road in accordance with the pray
er of the petitioners & Report of the viewers and that the
Report field notes and plat of survey be recorded
as by law required.
