Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore constructed at the November 1921 term of this Court to view and report upon said proposed County road described as follows:

Commencing at a spike driven in the ground 20 feet of the Wild Horse pavement and South 54° 43' West 1552 feet from the quarter section corner on the East of Section 1 Township 2 North Range 32, E.W.M.; thence running North 87° 15' East 335 feet; thence South 75° 15' East 338 feet; thence due South 1010 feet to the center of River Side Avenue at the center of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 32, E.W.M.

as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the Court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on December 10, 1921 and publicly read the second time on December 12, 1921.

And the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be opened as a public highway and the Court being satisfied that said road is of public utility and there being no objections or remonstrances on file against said petition or report,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the County Board of Road Viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that said road be opened for public use.
