REPORT OF COUNTY ROADMASTER

Pursuant to the Order Requesting County Roadmaster to Investigate, adopted by the above entitled Court the 18th of August, 1955, the undersigned as County Roadmaster, examined the petition adopted by the above entitled Court, as aforesaid.

The undersigned has examined the road mentioned in the petition hereinabove mentioned, and found said road to carry a large volume of vehicular traffic and to be in sad disrepair. Further, this road will require extensive grading, some drainage, graveling and probably paving within a short period of time.

It is my opinion that this road should be accepted as a County Road, even though the road at present is practically useless, because there seems to be some doubt as to the status of this road as regards to the classification established for said road by the immediate past County Court.

I conclude, therefore, and recommend that the said road be accepted and established as a County Road.
