

In the County Court of the State of Oregon  
for Umatilla County

In the matter of a County  
Road from a point on the  
Umatilla River opposite the  
North End of Lee Street in  
the City of Pendleton to a point  
on the Pendleton and Cold Spring  
road situated about 20 rods  
south of the north west corner  
of Section thirty five, town-  
ship three north of Range thirty-  
two East of the Willamette Meridian.

To the Honorable County Court in and for  
Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

The undersigned, householders within  
Umatilla County, State of Oregon, residing  
in the vicinity where the proposed County  
road herein after described is to be laid out  
and located, respectfully pray that that  
a County Road be laid out and located  
commencing at a point on the north Bank  
of the Umatilla River opposite the north  
End of Lee Street in the City of Pendleton in  
said County and State and running thence in  
a Northerly direction up and on either side  
of a gulch or Cañon, which empties into the  
Umatilla River at said first described point  
on the most practicable and easiest route  
to a point in the Pendleton and Cold Spring  
road situated about twenty rods south of

the North west corner of Section thirty  
five, township three, North of range thirty-two East of <sup>meridian</sup> ~~the~~ ~~line~~  
and your petitioners will ever pray.

Petitioners further represent that the proposed  
roads will afford an easier and more prac-  
ticable route from the City of Penobscot to  
that portion of the County lying North, North  
West and North East of Penobscot and will  
be a great convenience to persons residing  
in said portion of the County - and further  
show that the road from Penobscot to  
the point of intersection with the proposed  
County road, as the same is now travelled is  
less direct, steeper than the proposed road  
and at some seasons is exceedingly difficult  
and impracticable.
