Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard and it appearing to the court that a petition for the appointment of a Bee Inspector for Umatilla County has been heretofore filed herein and said petition being signed by more than 7 duly qualified petitioners and the court being advised in the premises

It is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said petition be and the same hereby is granted, that C G Rogers of Freeewater, Umatilla County, Oregon, be and he hereby is appointed Bee Inspector for Umatilla County, Oregon.

ROAD NO. 740.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road-viewers, heretofore instructed at the July 1912 term of this court to view, survey, and report upon said road No. 740, as a County Road for final hearing the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on August 7th, 1912, and publicly read the second time on August 8th, 1912, and said report and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and said board of County Road-viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report,

It is therefore hereby ORDERED that said report and field notes be recorded in the records of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road as petitioned for, to-wit: Commencing at a point 560 ft. North of SE corner of Sec. 1, Tp 2 N R 32 E W M., thence West along the center of the present traveled road to the County road at a point 590 ft. Southwesterly from the center of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 1, Tp 2 N. R. 32 E W M.

In the Matter of County Road
 petitioned for F E Sherman, et al.

ROAD NO. 741

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the petition of F E Sherman and 14 other freeholders, who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein said proposed road is to be laid out, praying this court to lay out and establish a County road as follows, Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of Sec. 34, Tp 1 N. R. 32, E W M., thence West 2436 ft. to a point in the county road 204 ft. East of the center of sec. 34, Tp 1 N R 32 E W M., said road to be 40 ft. wide; and the court finds that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said proposed road as by law required; that said notices were securely posted in a public place and in plain view of the public for more than 30 days prior to the presentation of said petition to this court. The court further finds that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of a notice on the bulletin board at the North door of the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, the place of holding the County Court; that said notice having been posted in a public place and in plain view of the public and remained so posted for more than 30 days prior to the presentation of said petition to this court, and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said petition,

It is hereby ORDERED that the Board of County Road-viewers, to-wit: Geary Kimbrell, as surveyor, W J Stockman and L C Rothrock as viewers, be and are hereby ordered and instructed to meet in Pendleton, Oregon, on the 20th day of August, 1912, or if unable to meet on that day, then within five days thereafter and proceed to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road and report their doings to this court at its next regular term.
