Now on this day there is presented to the County Court the petition of Robert Beilke, and others, praying this Court to cause to be laid out and established a County road commencing at the northeast corner of Section 1, Township 1 South, Range 31, E.W.M.;

And the Court finds that there is an objection or remonstrance on file to said proposed road, containing a greater number of names and legal signers than is contained on the petition:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That the Clerk of this Court proceed to advertise for bids for 100 cords of red fir, 4 ft. wood to be delivered f.o.b. Pendleton, and for 30 tons of Rock Springs coal to be delivered ~~at~~ at the Umatilla County Library. The Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Umatilla County, Oregon.

Now on this day there is presented to the Court a quit-claim deed ~~fix~~ from Tom R. Hampton and Nina L. Hampton, his wife, to Umatilla County, conveying a strip of land, beginning 27 feet East and 32 ft. south of the $\frac{1}{4}$ ~~sec~~ section corner on the north side of Sec. 6, Tp. 3 North, Range 32 E.W.M: thence south 175 ft. thence North 20° 45' East 201.7 ft; thence West 100 feet to the point of beginning, said strip of land to be used as a Public Road;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Court that said Deed be approved and the land accepted as a County Road of Umatilla County; that the same be recorded in the record of Deeds of Umatilla County, Oregon.

thence South $44^{\circ} 59'$ West 233.7 feet; thence South $48^{\circ} 59'$ West 214 feet to a point on the north side of the present County road, said strip of land to be used as a public road;
