In the matter of locating and establishing altering, changing and widening a road or highway from Cold Springs Landing on the Columbia River to Harps Ranch in Middle Cold Springs Canyon, same being known as the Cold Springs-Harpe Ranch Section of the Pendleton-Cold Springs Highway, in Umatilla County, Oregon and designated as County Road No. 842 said County Road No. 842 being an alteration and relocation of County Road No 1, from the Columbia River to the east line of the county road known as the Middle Cold Springs Road from the last mentioned line to the terminus.

ORDER Road No. 842

Now on this day this matter coming on for final hearing the same having been publicly read the first time February 7th, 1924 and publicly read the second time February 8th, 1924. said board finds that owners of land through which said road is to be laid out and established will be made less valuable by reason of establishing said road in the sum of nothing.

The court being of the opinion that said road is of public utility and needed as a part of the general road system of Umatilla County,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, as follows, commencing at Station 0 + 00 as indicated in the original resolution in the above entitled mater, thence to Station 864 + 02.0 P.T. terminus and said road be finally surveyed and opened.

Done and dated this 9th day of February, 1924.

In the matter of locating, establishing altering, changing and straightening and widening of a county road from Havana to Helix, in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, same being known as the Havana-Helix Road.

ORDER Road No. 843

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the resolution heretofore adopted by the Court at the January term of this court, showing its intention to establish a highway over the route indicated in said resolution, the width of said road to be 60 feet.

And the court finds that due notice of the hearing has been given by the posting of a certified copy of said resolution in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road at the west entrance of the county court in Pendleton, Oregon, being the place of holding the county court that each and all of said notices were securely posted in a public place in plain view of the public for at least thirty days prior to this hearing, and there being no remonstrances or objections on file,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that I.J. Shannon, I.A. Christopher, and Dave Nelson, be and they are hereby appointed as a Board of County Road Viewers to view and report on said proposed road and that said I.J. Shannon County Roadmaster and I.A. Christopher and Dave Nelson, as such Board of County Road Viewers are hereby ordered to meet at the beginning point of said proposed road on the 19th day of February, 1924 or if unable to mee, on that day then within ten days thereafter and proceed to view survey if necessary and report upon said proposed road at the next regular term of this court.

In the matter of locating, establishing altering, widening straightening and changing of a county road from Pilot Rock up east Birch Creek, in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, same being an alteration, and relocation of the old East Birch Creek County Road and County Road No 499

ORDER Road No 499

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the resolution heretofore adopted by the court at the January term 1924, thereof, showing its intentions to establish a highway over the route indicated in said resolution, the width of said road to be 60 feet.

And the court finds that due notice of the hearing has been given by the posting of certified copies of said resolution in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road at the west entrance of the county court house in Pendleton, Oregon being the place of holding the county court that each and all of said notices were securely posted in a public place in plain view of the public for at least thirty days prior to this hearing, and there being no remonstrances or objections on file.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that I.J. Shannon, Herbert Boylen and Carl Jensen, be and they are hereby appointed as a Board of County Road Viewers to view and report on said proposed road and that said I.J. Shannon County Roadmaster and Herbert Boylen and Carl Jensen as such board of county road viewers are hereby ordered to meet at the beginning point of said proposed road on the 19th day of February, 1924, or if unable to meet on that day then within ten days thereafter and proceed to view, survey of necessary and report upon said proposed road at the next regular term of this court.
