Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the February 1920 term of said Court, to view, survey and report upon said proposed road petitioned for as commencing at the school house at the northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 1 North, Range 34 E.W.M.; thence South along the quarter section line a distance of 120 rods; thence in a southeasterly direction on the most practical route to the southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 20, said township and range; Also, beginning on the east line of the County road at the northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 1, North, Range 34, E.W.M. thence east to the northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of ^{said} Section 20, as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been filed on February 21, 1920, and publicly read the first time on March 4, 1920, and publicly read the second time on March 5, 1920,

And the Court being satisfied that said road would be a public necessity; and there being no objections or remonstrances on file against said petition or report,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Court that the same be adopted; and that said road be opened and established as a public highway of Umatilla County; and the Plats and Field notes be recorded in the record of Plats and Fields Notes of Umatilla County.
