Decree of Vacation

Now on this day this matter coming on for hearing, this being the time and term for final decision by the court, and it appearing that the original resolution herein is now before the court, together with the report of the County Surveyor in the cause, and it appearing that due and lawful advertisement of the final hearing herein has been given by posting notice thereof at the place of holding this court, and also in three public places in the vicinity of the portion of said road so proposed to be vacated, all more than 30 days before the date set by the court for hearing, and it appearing that proof of said notice has been made by affidavit of the person who was named by the court to post said notices, and that such affidavit is now before the court, and it appearing that no objection has in any manner been made or filed to the proposed vacation, and it appearing that said portion of said road so proposed to be vacated is not useful as a part of the general road system of the County of Umatilla, Oregon, and it appearing that the public will be ~~warranted~~ ^{benefitted} by the proposed vacation, and that the portion of said road proposed to be vacated is not useful as the part of any general road system, and will not be in the future, and it appearing that it is not in use, and is what is known as a dead end or pocket, and is not of sufficient public benefit to warrant maintaining by the court;-

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED? ORDERED AND DECREED that the following portion of County Road Number 671, to wit, in Umatilla County, Oregon, commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter ^{of NE 1/4} of Section 21, Township 1, North, Range 34, E.W.M., Umatilla County, Oregon, and running thence West one half mile, more or less, to the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 21 is useless, dangerous and burdensome to maintain, is not in general public use, is unnecessary and expensive to maintain, is of no value to either individuals ~~and~~ or the general public, and is useless as a part of the general road system, and that the public will be benefitted by its vacation, and that the same is hereby vacated.
