Sir:

Referring to your two communications dated July 14, 1910, regarding the public roads across the Umatilla Reservation, the Department on July 29, 1910, modified its approval of April 2, 1910, so as to revoke the charge for driving stock across the reservation as provided in the Regulations of August 2, 1906, but all other parts of such regulations are to remain in force. At the same time the Department approved the recommendation of the Office that the protest of the Indians against the opening of the road running east from Cayuse be not considered.

There is enclosed for your information a copy of approved Office letter of July 27, 1910. You are requested to notify the county authorities accordingly.
