

IN THE MATTER OF VIEWING, SURVEYING AND LAYING OUT COUNTY ROAD NO. 394

To the Honorable County Court, of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County :

We, the undersigned, the Viewers heretofore appointed to view and locate Road No. 394 submit the following report: Pursuant to an order of the Honorable Court we met Geo. B. Arnold, County Surveyor, at Meacham on 13th day of June 1892 and were by him, each, duly sworn to faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of our appointments.

who were by the Surveyor, each, duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed and located said Road No.

394 as specified in our order, as near, as in our opinion a good road can be made; we varied from the route specified in one instance, to wit: After crossing the Rail Road track, as specified in petition, instead of running south along east side of said R. R. track to the center line of Sec. 14 and then running east, we ran on S. E. course, to avoid making bridge, and culvert, and to avoid impracticable grades, which we encountered in viewing out the road as described in petition. This road is located where there are no other county roads near, and upon good ground; will be easy to open and keep in repair; we would recommend that said road 394, as viewed and surveyed, be declared a public highway.
