

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County :

We, the undersigned your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit :

Commencing at a rock 8x12x22 inches, set 16 inches in the ground, (said rock having two notches on the north side and two notches on its top end) said rock being placed at the fork of Stewart Creek on unsurveyed land, being about three-fourths of a mile in a south-westerly direction from the south-east corner of section 17, in Township 1, South of Range 33, East, of Willamette Meridian; Thence running in a westerly direction along the north bank of Stewart Creek as near the foot-hill as practicable, on said unsurveyed land, to a point about two hundred yards south of the half mile section corner post of section 24, on the Township line between townships 1, South of Range 32 and 33 East, thence running westerly along the course of said Stewart Creek, by the most practicable route across section 24, thence running diagonally across the north-east quarter of section 23, in a north westerly direction, to a point on the section line between sections 14 and 23, about 100 yards east of where Stewart Creek crosses said section line, thence running due west along said section line between sections 14 and 23 to south-east corner of section 15, Township 1, South of range 32, E W M, there intersecting County Road No. 292

Said road to be Forty feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
