Court met pursuant to adjournment present the same Judge and officers as of yesterday and after due proclamation of the opening of Court by the proper officer the following proceedings were had.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers heretofore appointed at the April 1887 Term of this Court. to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this Court. to-wit July 1887 term. and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road. and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same.

And it appearing to the Court that a remonstrance has been filed against the granting of said road. the remonstrators appearing by Jas. A. Fee and Turner Crews of counsel and the petitioners appearing by R. J. Slater of counsel and the same having been argued to the Court on a previous day of this term and the same was taken under advisement by the Court. and the Court being now fully advised.

It is therefore ordered by the Court <sup>that said report</sup> be accepted and the road ordered opened for the reason that there are more names on the petition than on the remonstrance of legal <sup>and remonstrators</sup> petitioners and it is ordered that said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers. and that the report of said viewers. field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required. and it is further ordered that the Supervisor through whose district said road runs. be directed to open the same for public use as a County road.
