 Oregon respectfully ask for the survey and location of
 a county road as follows to wit Beginning in the
 middle of the County road at a point opposite the old
 Smith Station at the foot of the Smith Hill from thence
 up the old Smith hill along the present traveled road
 to the top of said hill thence in a north westerly direction
 following the present traveled stage road to the foot of
 the hill at a point where ^{said} road intersects the line of the
 B. N. & O. R. R thence down the gulch in a westerly
 direction to a point where the new mill stage station
 used to stand thence leaving the present traveled stage
 road and running down the rail road Canyon to
 a point near the house of D. L. Moorhouse thence continuing
 down said Canyon to what is known as Cold Spring thence
 on the nearest and most practicable route to Umatilla
 Landing on the Columbia river for which your
 petitioners will ever pray -
