3 Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard
4 upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instr-
5 ucted at the February term 1910 of this Court to view survey, stake
6 and report on said proposed road No 679, COMMENCING at the Northeast
7 corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 Tp 4 N.R. 29 E.W.M, run thence North
8 45 degrees East 7,300 feet through section 22 and 15 in said Tp &
9 Range to the NW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14 in Tp 4 N.R. 29
10 E.W.M.; thence north 2640 feet to the SW corner of Section 11 said
11 Tp and Range; thence east 10,560 feet to the northeast corner of
12 section 13 said Tp & Range, and to be 60 feet wide as a County Road
13 for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different
14 days of the same term of Court, to-wit; having been publicly read
15 the first time on March 3rd, 1910 and publicly read the second time
16 on March 4th 1910, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having
17 reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as
18 a County road, and the plat and field notes being on file and certi-
19 fied to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and their being
20 no remonstrance or objections on file against said report or petition
21 and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient
22 public utility, it is, THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said report of
23 Board of Road Viewers be accepted and that the plat and field notes
24 be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla Cou-
25 nty and that the Road Master of Umatilla County be and he is hereby
26 ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.
