To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County Road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the common corner to sections 27 28 33 and 34 T.5 N.R.29 E. Will.Meri. thence east on section line as near as practicable six miles to a point where said line strikes the Holdman and Cold Springs station wheat road at or near the common corner to sections 27 28 33 and 34 T.5 N.R.30 E. Will.Meri. and there terminating. Provided however that said road shall be so located that there shall be no grade greater than a 5 per cent grade.

Said road to be 60 feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
