OPENING ROAD NO 696.

Now on this day this matter coming on to be hear upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the January, 1911 term of this Court, to view, survey, stake and report upon said proposed road No 696, petitioned for as follows; COMMENCING, at SW cor NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 27 Tp 5 N.R. 29 E.W.M. thence running east one mile to the SE cor NE $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section, and to be forty feet wide, as a County road, for final hearing, the same having been read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit; having been publicly read the first time on Feb, 1st, 1911, and publicly read the second time on Feb, 2nd, 1911, and the said Board of county road viewers, having reported favorably and recomended that said road be declared a County road and it appearing to the Court that said road will be of sufficient public utility to justify the same be opened as a public road, but not of sufficient public utility to justify the Court in paying in damages, it is therefore hereby ordered that said report of the board of County Road Viewers be approved and that the plat and filed notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the Road Master of Umatilla County, or the road supervisor ~~of~~ through whose district said road runs, be and he is hereby instructed to open said road for public use as soon as the petitioners have paid the damages awarded by said viewers, to-wit, the sum of \$20.00 allowed Mr. Taber, owner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 27 aforesaid and when the petitioners have re-embursed said Taber for trees along said route.
