

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows,

to-wit: Commencing at a point at the end of the diagonal road in the center of Section 16, T5N, R.28E, W. 11. thence running north and west about six hundred feet over the brow of the hill, thence running south and west on a grade not to exceed five per cent to the center of section line between Sections 16 and 17 of the aforesaid township and range, thence running west and north about six hundred feet to the present railroad crossing, thence north on the west side of the railroad to the quarter place of the above mentioned Section 17 parallel with the railroad, thence in a westerly course to the east end of Sixth St. of the City of Umatilla and there terminating.

Said Road to be sixty feet wide.

And your petitions will ever pray.
