

ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN.

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the May term 1894 of said County Court, to-wit: On the 11th day of May 1894, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the initial post in Road Survey No. 342, which is a sawed fir 4 ins. sq. marked N 1 on W. face, and R on S. face, near head of grade, on W. side of lower crossing of McKay creek, and in S.E. cor. of sec. 20. T. 2 N. R. 32 E.

Following said Road Survey, No. 342, thence, to its intersection with the line bet. secs. 29 & 32, in said Tp; thence, up a certain ravine, to intersect the line bet. secs. 5 and 6, in T. 1 N. R. 32 E. at a point about 150 yds. S. of cor. to secs. 5. 6. 31 & 32; thence S. along sec. line, to the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. said secs. 5 & 6; thence W. to intersect said Road Survey No. 342.; thence along said survey No. 342, as near as may be for the best road, to its terminus; thence, continuing up Comb's cañon, on best rout, to Scale's well; thence up the N. fork of Comb's cañon, on best rout. to int. line bet. ranges 30 & 31 E. W. 7th.

Said road to be _____ feet wide.
