In County Court, March 1901 Term, 189

Sixth Judicial Day, Saturday March 7, 189-1901

It is therefore ordered, that said road be established as a county road in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the said field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as required by law, and the supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a county road.

In the matter of County Road # 523 commencing at the terminus of road # 422 on the north line of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 21, Tp. 2 N Range 32 E. W. 7th. thence in a southerly direction crossing the line between Secs 20 and 21, and Termination at the initial point of road # 437 in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 20, Tp. 2 North, R 32 E. W. 7th. said proposed road, to be about 1 mile in length

Road # 523.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers of Barnhart B F Rinn and P D Hanford, heretofore appointed at the January, 1901 Term of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a county road, for final hearing the same having been read, upon a previous day of this term of this Court, to-wit the January 1901 Term and the said viewers having reported favourably, and recommended the establishing the same as a county road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file, and certified to, by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrances on file against said road, it is therefore ordered that the report of the viewers be accepted.

It is, therefore ordered, that said road be established as a county road, in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the said field notes, and plat of survey, thereof be recorded, as required by law, and the supervisor through whose district said road runs, be directed, to open the same for public use, as a county road.
