

# To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts, where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point 80 rods south of the south west corner of section 36 in TP. 4, N, R, 27, E. W. M. Thence running due east until intersecting with canal of the western irrigation Company as now constructed over and across section one in TP. 3, N, R, 27 E. W. M. thence following along the northerly side of said canal until intersecting with the north and south section line between sections one in TP. 3, N, R, 27, and Section 1 *Sit* in TP. 3 ~~East~~ north of range 28, E. W. M. thence running north along said section line to the northeast corner of said section one, in TP. 3, N, R, 27, E. W. M. terminating at said last named point. Said road to be ~~eighty~~ <sup>forty</sup> feet wide.

"Your petitioners respectfully show that there is a public necessity for said road in that the territory through which the said road reaches will be watered by the McKay Creek Reservoir and that the said territory will be much more closely settled; that the lands will be cut into smaller tracts and that this road is necessary to give access to such tracts; that the lands after the project at McKay Creek is completed will greatly increase in value and that the said road should be now established so as to prevent an exorbitant cost for the right of way.
